Who We Serve

For the NOHFC, Northern Ontario is defined as "all areas North of, and including, the districts of Parry Sound and Nipissing."

NOHFC provides economic development funding toward approved projects in the territorial districts of Northern Ontario, namely Algoma, Cochrane, Kenora, Manitoulin, Nipissing, Parry Sound, Rainy River, Sudbury, Thunder Bay and Timiskaming.



INVEST North - Innovation

Supporting R&D, and commercialization of new and innovative technologies.

Who is eligible?

Private-sector businesses alone, or in partnership with a public sector academic or research institution.

What is eligible?

Applied R&D projects, and demonstration & commercialization of new and innovative technologies.

NOHFC defines <u>innovative technology projects</u> as: "the development or implementation of ideas to produce new or improved strategies, capabilities, products, services, or processes with a strong focus on ensuring to satisfy a market need or desire".

Assisting with the **launch** of new businesses, **growth** and expansion of existing businesses, or the **location** of new business operations to Northern Ontario.



INVEST North - Investment

Who is eligible?

Businesses starting-up, expanding existing operations or locating new business operations in or to Northern Ontario.

What is eligible?

Capital construction, leasehold improvements, new or used equipment including capital leases, land servicing costs, information & communications technology (ICT) investments, <u>marketing for new products</u> and business initiatives, <u>Training costs</u> incurred with third parties.

Funding

Funding Stream	Funding Type	Available Funding
Launching a new business	Conditional Contribution	50% of eligible costs, up to \$200,000
Growing an existing business	Conditional Contribution/Loan or both	\$400,000 in conditional contribution, \$400,000 in conditional contribution or \$600,000 in term loan, or \$1 million in term loan-only.
Locating new business operations to Northern Ontario	Conditional Contribution	50% of eligible costs, up to \$5 million

INVEST North – Strategic Initiative

Innovation - Industrial Research Chair

Supporting the establishment and enhancement of research capacity at Northern Ontario universities, colleges, and research institutions.

Who is eligible?

Northern Ontario universities, colleges, and research institutions

What is eligible?

- Salary and mandatory benefits of the chair holder
- construction or renovation of laboratories or supporting facilities
- Acquiring, operating and maintaining research equipment

- Materials used directly in carrying out the research
- Costs associated with publishing research findings

Funding

Financial assistance is limited to 50% of eligible costs (max of \$1 million) as a conditional contribution for the duration of the project.

INVEST North – Strategic Initiatives Grow – Regional Tile Drainage

Who is eligible?

Not-for-profit, agricultural or community organizations that would, on behalf of an identified consortium of producers, develop and administer a project to install tile drainage within a specific region

What is eligible?

Tile drainage contractor costs (materials and labour), project management/administration fees of the service provider, and land to be tiled can be in production or new acreage

Funding

The maximum investment from the NOHFC will not exceed the lesser of 50% or \$1 million towards eligible project costs.

The People & Talent Program is designed to attract, retain and develop Northern Ontario's workforce.

The people and talent program is comprised of two funding streams:

- Indigenous Workforce Development Program
 - Strengthening and developing Northern Ontario's Indigenous workforce through business partnerships by offering internships to Indigenous persons.
- Workforce Development Program
 - Strengthening and developing Northern Ontario's workforce through business partnerships by offering internships.

People and Talent

Who is eligible?

Businesses, municipalities, Indigenous communities, and not-for-profit organizations located in Northern Ontario that have been in operation for at least one year and have minimum of one full-time employee.

What is eligible?

Salaries/wages and employer portion of Mandatory Employment Related Costs (MERCs) for a limited-term internship position of 52 weeks at 35 hours/week.

Support priorities of rural communities to contribute to healthy and strong communities.

Who is eligible?

Municipalities, Indigenous communities, not-for-profit organizations, and Local Services Boards located in Northern Ontario.

What is eligible?

Incremental improvements, repairs, and/or renovations to improve and extend the useful life of capital assets including; social and recreational facilities, municipal assets and community halls, that contribute to a healthy and vibrant community.

Funding Stream	Funding Type	Available Funding
Rural Enhancement Project For Indigenous communities or communities with a population <u>under</u> 1,500.	Conditional Contribution	90% of eligible costs to a maximum of \$200,000
Rural Enhancement Project For communities with a population <u>over</u> 1,500.	Conditional Contribution	75% of eligible costs to a maximum of \$500,000

Who is eligible?


Municipalities, Indigenous communities, not-for-profit organizations, and Local Services Boards located in Northern Ontario.

What is eligible?

Incremental improvements, repairs, and/or renovations to improve and extend the useful life of capital assets including; social and recreational facilities, municipal assets and community halls, that contribute to a healthy and vibrant community.

Community Enhancement – Strategic Initiative Broadband and Cellular Expansion Projects

Addressing broadband gaps in northern Ontario by increasing connectivity for unserved or underserved areas.

Who is eligible?

Municipalities, municipal organizations, Indigenous Communities, and Community- based-networks or ICT community champions in Northern Ontario

What is eligible?

Projects that improve broadband and cellular coverage to areas with broadband download speeds of less than 25 megabits per second (mbps) and projects that expand cellular coverage along the Trans-Canada and King's Highways.

Funding

Funding Stream	Funding Type	Available Funding	
Broadband and Cellular Expansion Projects	Conditional Contribution	50% of eligible costs up to a maximum of \$1 million dollars with a targeted funding of \$500 per dwelling (average) within the coverage area.	
 Projects that deliver 50 mbps or greater will be considered up to \$1,500 per dwelling. To be eligible, have applied to and have been declined funding under other Ontario infrastructure programs, including the Improving Connectivity in Ontario (ICON) program administered by the Ministry of Infrastructure (MOI) and/or do not meet the eligibility requirements.

Cultural Supports



The Cultural Supports Program is designed to help showcase Northern Ontario culture, geography and talent through event partnerships and the production of films and television series.

Who is eligible?

Municipalities, Indigenous communities, not-for-profit organizations, and Local Services Boards located in Northern Ontario for events and Canadian production companies for film and television.

What is eligible?

•New and recurring in-person or virtual community-based and/or tourism events that attract tourists (Event Partnership).

•Annual and/or recurring events that include new programming or activities and are anticipated to improve the quality and/or sustainability of the event (Event Partnership).

•Theatrical feature films, scripted television series, made-for-television movies and documentaries (Film and Television)

Community Events	Conditional Contribution	Max \$15,000
Film & Television For communities with a population <u>over</u> 1,500.	Conditional Contribution	Tiered funding based on total production cost, up to \$2 million
